Types of Tablets

- iOS (iPad)
- Android (Samsung, LG, Moto, etc.)
- Windows

How to Connect to Wi-Fi

1. "Settings"
2. "Wi-Fi"
3. Tap the name of the Wi-Fi network you want to join.
4. Enter a password, if needed.



Apps

- App is short for application
- Apps are the icons on your home screen
- Each app has a different function
- You can personalize your apps, but some apps cannot be removed

App Store / Play Store

- This is where you can download and purchase new apps
- To use the App Store / Play Store, you need to have an account

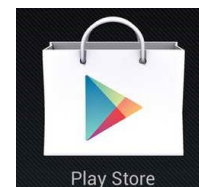
For iOS:

- Apple ID (Ex/ [name@email.com](#))
- Password (Ex/ Password1243)



For Android:

- Google account (ex/ [name@gmail.com](#))
- Password (ex/ Password1234)



How to Use the Camera

To take a picture:

1. "Camera"
2. Select front or back camera.
3. Tap the shutter button in the bottom-centre of your screen.
4. To take a video, tap the record button, on and off.



To view a picture:

1. "Gallery" OR "Photos"
2. Tap on the picture you want to view.



Email

- Email allows you to send messages from one device to another
- You need to have an Internet connection
- With your email address & password, you can access your email on any device



Video Calling

- You can see and hear the person you are talking to and they can see and hear you
- You need to have an Internet connection
- The people you are calling need to have the same video calling app

- Skype

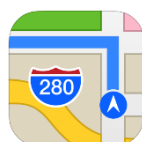


Maps
